- Document progress of children (IPP goals) and ensure child records are maintained
- Participate in professional growth opportunities
- Work collaboratively on a team of professionals which may include Speech Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Behavior Consultants and Psychologists
- Incorporate recommendations and strategies provided by consultants into classroom activities and daily routines and provide feedback on the recommendations
- Supervise and coach classroom educational assistants
